SPREADER SERVICING UNDERWAY


The Swan Heavy Mechanical team has been hard at work recently, focusing on general servicing and maintenance of the Swan Brothers spreaders.

RILEY BACK ON BOARD


Swan Brothers have been fortunate to have an extra set of hands over the past three weeks, with Riley McNicol rejoining the team during his university break.

SWAN AGRI BUSINESS UPDATES


Graham and Cody have been helping the Swan Agri team on the farm recently with calf marking, an important part of managing young stock.

COORONG REALTY OFFICE MOVE UPDATE


You may have noticed that the Coorong Realty office has recently relocated. We've moved to the other end of 93 Railway Terrace, where we're settling into our refreshed space.


